 - a. Request for motion to approve of tree bid to remove tree at NW corner of Coolidge and Hazel, Miner Tree Service bid \$1,100 and Konfrst Tree Service bid \$600.

 - d. Exploring the option of City and County officials getting together to talk about building codes
