

Glenwood City Council Minutes
July 26, 2016

Glenwood City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, July 26, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Brian Tackett called the meeting to order with the following present: Council Members – Susan Hirschman; Jessie Lundvall; and Jeremy Wade Rodman; Police Chief Eric Johansen; Public Works Director Perry Cook; Library Director Tara Painter; and Office Assistant Mike Flack for City Clerk Angie Winqvist– Guests: Kory Ihnken. 1. Council member Rodman reported for Public Safety held prior to tonight's meeting at 6:30pm to meet with Chief Johansen to discuss amending Ordinance; Chapter 69.13 stricken no parking 107 S. Locust; 69.08 making no parking on the west side of Myrtle Street between Sharp Street and First Street and 69.14; limited parking on Vine Street, on the east side from the school property line at the south end of East Florence. Council instructed Johansen to go forward with City Attorney Woods to draft these changes
