Total funds with grants and donations total \$4,647,056; expenses total \$5,168,393 with a short fall of \$521,337. George with JEO went over possible deductions for council to consider; which will be decided at the next council meeting. Susanne with PFM explained the financing with the bonds and LOST funds and explained the official statement to Council.

Susanne Gerlach with PFM presented the preliminary official statement to introduce Resolution #3384 to be adopted by Council for the purpose of approving the preliminary official statement for the City's General Obligation Bonds; Series 2015A and 2015B; a General Obligation LOST swimming pool refunding bonds for \$5,030,000 and an additional General Obligation loan agreement for \$500,000 for the purpose of paying library roof repairs and street improvements on Vine Street and Railroad Avenue
