

Glenwood Aquatic Center Rules

- No diving in the shallow ends of the swimming pool and in other areas marked “No Diving”
- No rough play in or around the swimming pool
- No running on deck
- No person is permitted to use the pool without first having taken a warm water shower, using soap
- No person having an obvious communicable disease, cut, sore or lesion, eye, ear, nose, or throat infection, is permitted to use any public swimming pool
- Spitting or spouting water, blowing nose, or any other similar activities in the swimming pool is strictly prohibited
- Children 7 years of age or under must be accompanied in the pool water by parent, guardian, grandparent or babysitter, 16 or over, that is within arm’s reach at all times
- No swimming without lifeguard supervision
- No glass of any kind allowed in the pool, on deck, or in the locker room
- No Tobacco of any kind is allowed including: cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, or electronic cigarettes such as E-cigarettes, vapes, Juuls, etc.
- Eating, drinking, and chewing gum is prohibited in the pool area
- Abusive or foul language is prohibited
- No diving in any area of the pool that is less than 9 feet deep
- No prolonged underwater breath holding allowed
- Climbing on water features is no allowed
- Do not play with or touch any of the ropes
- Proper swim attire is required in the pool
- Respect the lifeguards, they are there for your safety

Anyone not abiding by these rules
will be asked to leave the premises!
