

**ORDINANCE NO. 907**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD, IOWA CONCERNING CHICKENS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS.

BE it enacted by the City of Glenwood, Iowa:

CHAPTER ADDED: Chapter 56, Section Ten (10) is hereby added to read in full as follows:

**56.10      TERMINATION OF CHAPTER.**

1. Commencing August 1, 2021, no permits, with the exception of renewal of permits under §56.02, shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 56 of the City Code of Ordinances to any person, firm, association, or other entity seeking to possess, control, keep, or harbor chickens as defined in this Chapter. Any person, firm, association, or other entity that has in existence on August 1, 2021, a valid permit or renewal permit used pursuant to Section 56.02 of the City Code of Ordinances shall be able to timely seek renewal permits for chickens in their respective possession pursuant to this Chapter, but shall not be able to add any more chickens to its possession under the terms of Chapter 56 after July 31, 2021.
2. Any person, firm, association, or other entity that has a validly issued permit or renewal permit pursuant to the terms of Chapter 56 of City Code of Ordinances shall comply with all the terms and conditions of Chapter 56 of the Code of Ordinances to continue to possess, harbor, control, and keep its chickens which exist as of July 31, 2021 within the corporate limits of the City of Glenwood.
3. This Chapter shall terminate and be considered repealed when there are no further chickens harbored within the corporate limits of the City pursuant to this Chapter of the Code of Ordinances.
