## Design Workshop to be Held for Glenwood Resource Center Redevelopment Plan Project

April 17, 2023 (Glenwood, Iowa) – The Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) is working with local leaders to reimagine the 380-acre Glenwood Resource Center (GRC) campus to provide Glenwood with an asset that can be a source of community pride. The resulting master plan will:

- Reflect input from stakeholders and the public
- Consider cultural resources and sensitivities
- Define opportunities for improved access
- Promote economic synergies and employment opportunities
- Provide a roadmap for sustained growth

A consensus-driven vision will be developed that recognizes GRC's historical significance and the potential for transformation. The public is invited to join the project team at a Design Workshop April 24<sup>th</sup> through April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023, from 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. each night on the GRC campus in the Meyers Building gymnasium. The workshop is an opportunity for the public to learn more about the project and provide input.

Public input will be requested as a part of the Design Workshop. The workshop will last four days, and each evening, the public will be invited to learn about the day's work and provide comments and feedback. The next day, the project team will work to incorporate feedback and comments from the previous evening. The process repeats until the last day, where the goal is to have consensus on the preferred redevelopment plan.
