



Glenwood Aquatic Center Rules

- No diving in the shallow ends of the swimming pool and in other areas marked “No Diving”.
- No rough play in or around the swimming pool.
- No running on deck.
- No person is permitted to use the pool without first having taken a warm water shower, using soap.
- No person having an obvious communicable disease, cut, sore or lesion, eye, ear, nose, or throat infection, is permitted to use any public swimming pool.
- Spitting or spouting water, blowing nose, or any other similar activities in the swimming pool is strictly prohibited.
- Children 9 years of age or under must be accompanied in the facility at all times by a parent, guardian, grandparent or babysitter who is 16 or over. Children 5 and under must be accompanied within arm’s reach at all times.
- No swimming without lifeguard supervision.
- No glass of any kind allowed in the pool, on deck, or in the locker room.
- No Tobacco of any kind is allowed including: cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, or electronic cigarettes such as E-cigarettes, vapes, Juuls, etc.
- Eating, drinking, and chewing gum is prohibited in the pool area.
- Abusive or foul language is prohibited.
- No diving in any area of the pool that is less than 9 feet deep.
- No prolonged underwater breath holding allowed.
- Do not play with or touch any of the ropes.
- Proper swim attire is required in the pool.
- Respect the lifeguards, they are there for your safety.
- Membership cards are to be used only for assigned members, misuse of cards or sharing of cards can result in pool suspension or forfeiture of season pass.

Anyone not abiding by these rules
will be asked to leave the premises!
