2023 City Election Calendar

Regular City/School Election: Tuesday November 7, 2023

Wednesday August 9, 2023

Certification of Nomination Process.

Deadline for city clerk to certify nomination process to controlling auditor. No changes may be made after certification.

Monday August 28, 2023

Regular City Election Candidate Filing Begins

First day to file nomination papers with the city clerk.

Saturday September 16, 2023

Last Day for Vacancies for Cities without Primary Election Provisions

In cities without primary election provisions, vacancies occurring on or before today must be filles at the regular city/school election. Vacancies occurring after this date cannot be filled at the year's regular city/school election and instead must wait to be filled until the next intervening special election for the city or the next regular city/school election.

Thursday September 21, 2023

Regular City Election Filing Deadline

Last day to file nomination papers with the city clerk. Deadline is 5 p.m.

City clerk's offices must be open until 5 p.m.

Friday September 22, 2023

Regular City Election Nominations and Public Measures Delivered

City clerk must deliver to the controlling auditor the full text of all public measures to be included on the regular city election ballot and any nomination papers to the **auditor by 12:00 noon.**

Tuesday September 26, 2023

Regular City Election Candidate Withdrawal Deadline

Last day for candidates to withdraw by filing a written request with the city clerk. Deadline is 5 p.m.

Regular City Election Candidate Objection Deadline

Last day to file written objections to nomination papers or eligibility of a candidate with the city clerk. **Deadline is 5 p.m.**

Wednesday October 18, 2023

First day of Absentee Voting for the Regular City/School Election

Monday October 23, 2023

Regular City/School Election Voter Pre-Registration Deadline

The deadline to pre-register to vote for the regular City/School Election is 5 p.m. This applies to registration in person (including registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail.

Exceptions: Mailed voter registration forms postmarked on or before the worry-free postmark date are considered on time even if they are received **after 5 p.m. today.**

After today, a person may register to vote at the auditor's office only and vote an absentee ballot. The process is the same as for registering to vote on election day.

Deadline to request absentee to be mailed for regular city/school election.

Monday November 6, 2023

Absentee Ballot In-Person Deadline for Regular City/School Election

Last day to request and vote absentee ballot in person at auditor's office.

Tuesday November 7, 2023

Regular City/School Election Day

Polls are open **from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.** Polling locations will be the same as the Primary and General locations.
